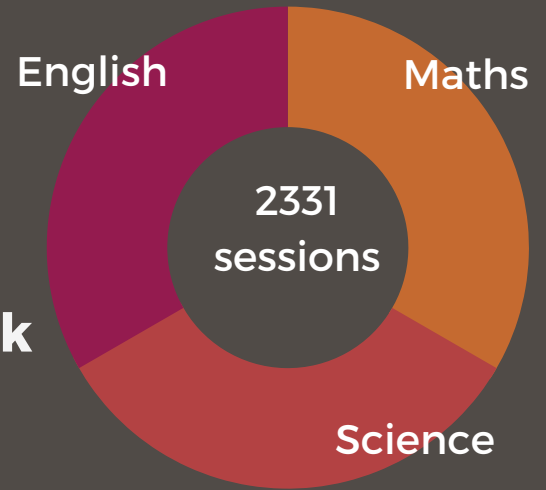

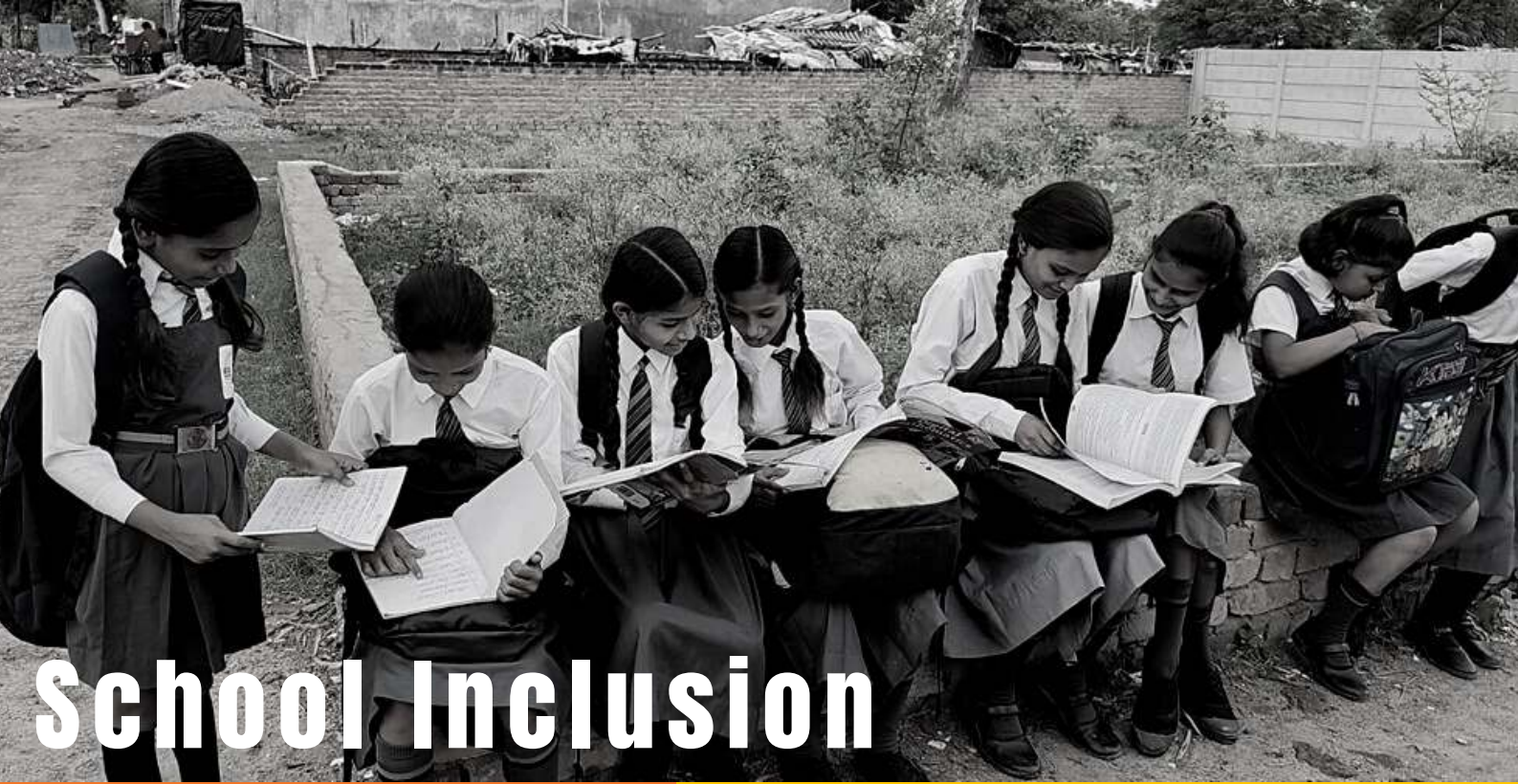


Spread the Warmth in collaboration with Radio City

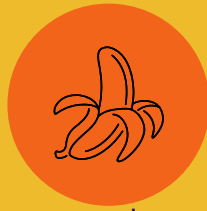

Gurukul is a model rural school that incorporates all the elements of a Sarthak Yellow Room into the formal school structure. The school offers marginalised children from poor rural backgrounds equitable, happy, gender-sensitive, well structured and digitally aided formal education at zero cost.

The school is attended by 480 children from 32 villages.

A DIGITAL EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME FOR 2400 GIRLS

Supported by Dell Technologies

Sarthak Resilience Incubator aims to improve the employability potential of 16-21 year old girls from Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in-person and online workshops and lectures.

The incubator has two levels of participants. The older level-1 girls conduct part of the training for the younger level-2 girls as a way to pay-forward their learnings and gain leadership skills.
