




















Activities at Summer Workshop



Round Table India Sarthak Gurukul





Gurukul is a model rural school that incorporates all the elements of a Sarthak Yellow Room into the formal school structure. The school offers marginalised children from poor rural backgrounds equitable, happy, gender—sensitive, well structured and digitally aided formal education at very low cost.

The school is attended by 646 children from 70 villages.

We are delighted to share with you the wonderful news of expansion of RTI Sarthak Gurukul with 4 new classrooms. The inauguration was conducted by Round Table India & Ladies Circle India who have been our strongest pillars of support.

Gurukul has now received affiliation till class 8!!







<u>Sarthak Yellow SLATEs</u> (<u>Sciences, Languages, Arts, Theater and Ethics</u>)

This year, we bring our Yellow Rooms model into the government school system of UP. We call this project - Yellow SLATEs.

The aim is to improve upon children's foundational literacy & numeracy, digital literacy and communication skills/expressions/confidence while also imparting good moral values and improving their cultural awareness.

We have prepared a custom curriculum called Naitik Shiksha that will use stories from Indian sources such as Jaatak Kathaein, Panchatantra, Hitopadesh and Amar Chitrakatha. We will deliver this using the medium of theatre and storytelling.



Like our Yellow Rooms, Yellow SLATEs is a long term intervention. Yellow SLATEs will reach out to 800-400 children per school.

Location : Government Composite School Adarsh Nagar, Rauza Balliya, Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh.


