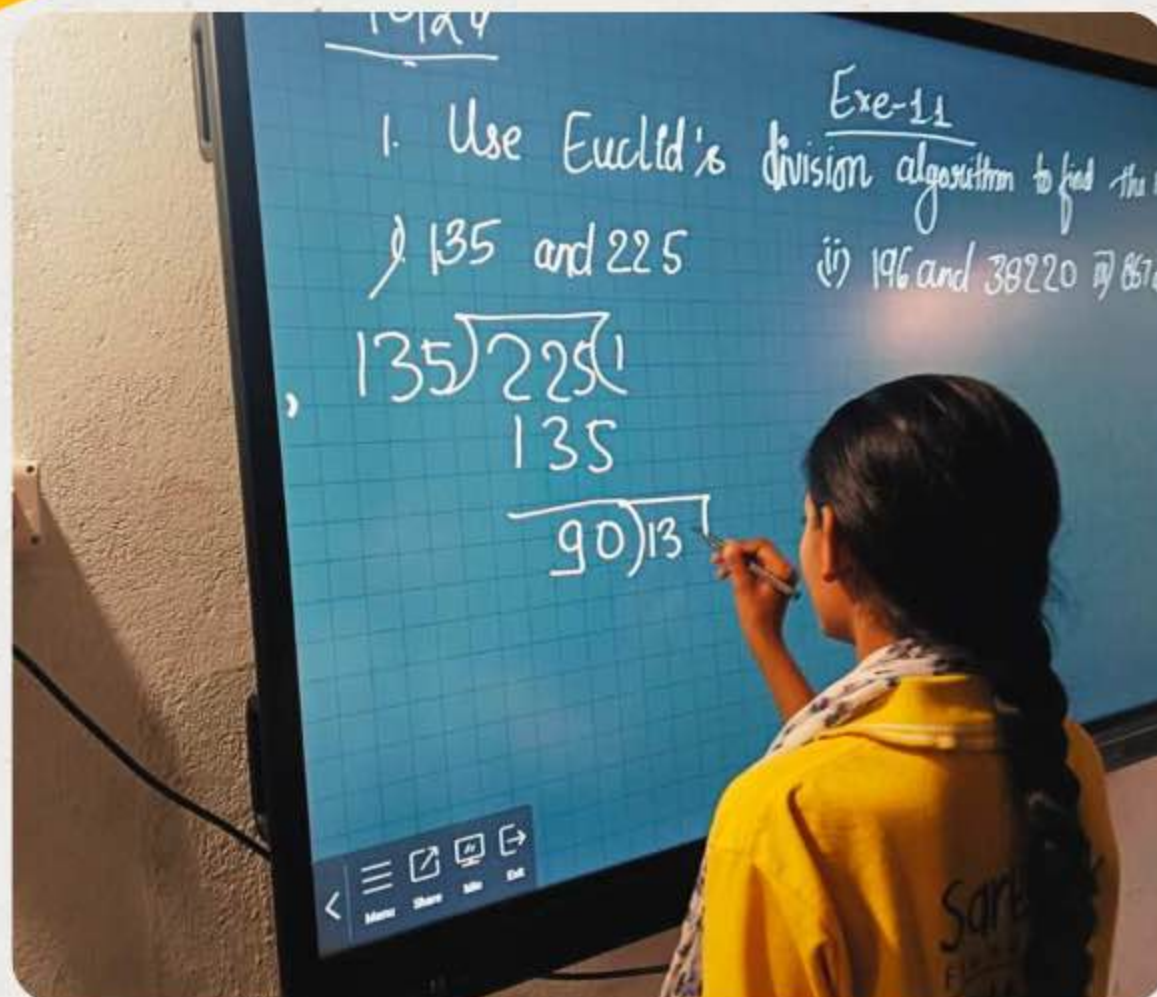

# SEPET

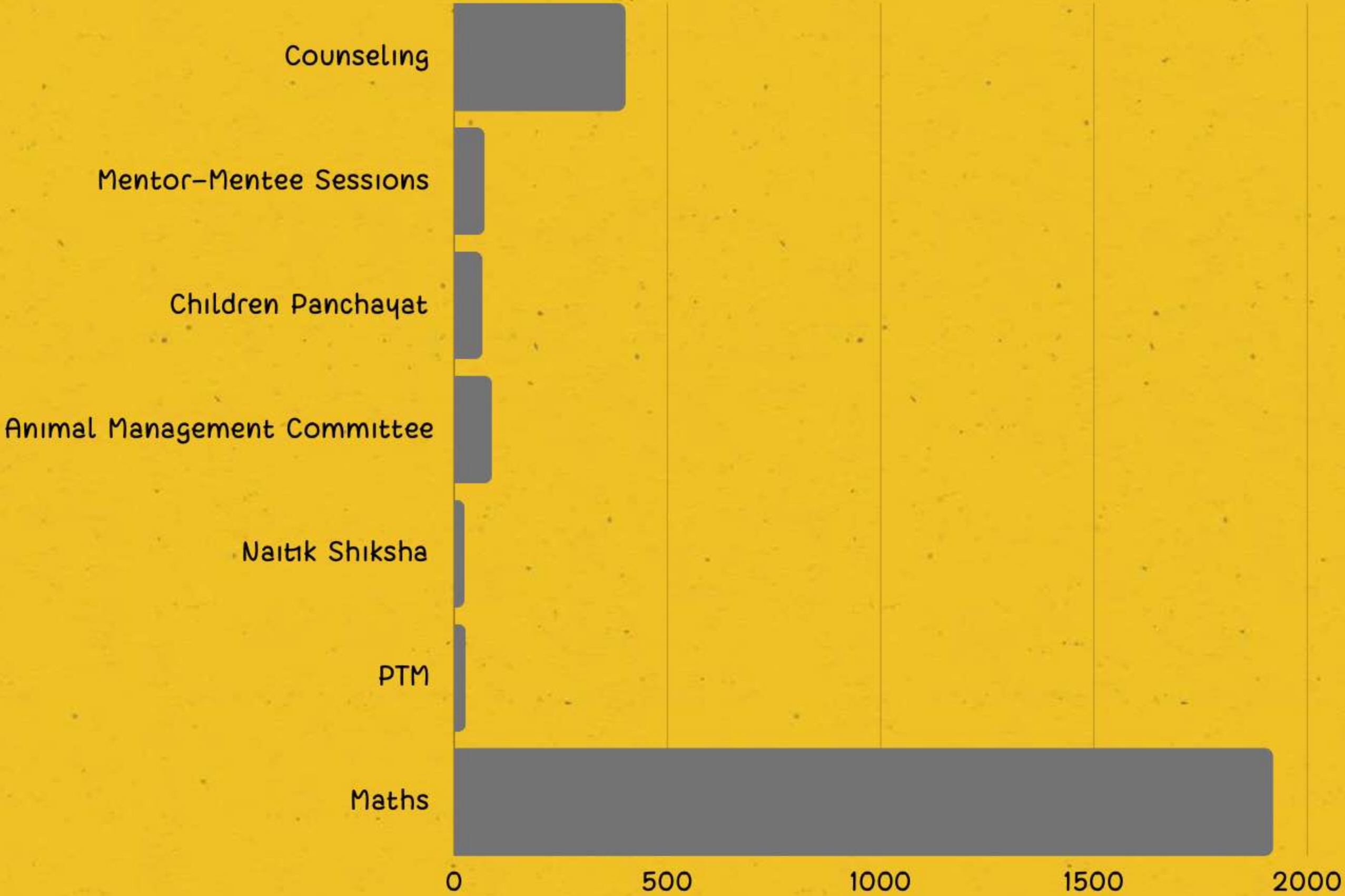
